2018 Guide to Master's Course Entrance Examinations

Department of Architecture, Graduate School of Engineering, The University of Tokyo

1. Eligibility

In order to apply for the entrance examination, prospective students must meet the requirements set by the Graduate School of Engineering. Refer to Guidelines for Applicants to the 2018 Master's Program Graduate School of Engineering, the University of Tokyo for details.

There are no restrictions regarding past fields of specialization (majors/degrees) or year(s) when qualifications (degrees) were attained. Master's Course entrance examinations are conducted once a year.

2. Supervising Professors and Application Forms

Students enrolled in the Graduate School pursue their research under a supervising professor. Therefore, applicants must select a supervising professor with whom they wish to work with from the list of faculty members. Applicants may apply for up to three faculty members of their choice. All applicants must write the name of their first choice faculty member on Department of Architecture application form Sheet 1B. It is not mandatory to include a second and/or third choice of supervising professor.

On Sheet 1A (Future Research Plan), write about your research topic and research plan and describe what you wish to accomplish in your graduate studies. Please send Sheets 1A, 1B, and 1C together with the other application documents from the Graduate School of Engineering.

3. Number of Accepted Students and Admission Dates & Deadlines

The Department of Architecture Master's Course will accept 32 students in academic year 2018*. The number of students admitted to each professor is restricted in order to avoid unbalanced research environments within the department. Normally, admitted students enter graduate school in April. Students who complete undergraduate courses by the end of September may enter the graduate school in September, as stated in *Graduate School Admission Information*.

^{*}The Japanese academic year starts on April 1 and ends on March 31.

4. Examinations

Applicants will be evaluated based on written and oral entrance examinations as described below.

(B) Oral examination

Oral examinations will be conducted as individual interviews in either Japanese or English. Each applicant will be allotted several minutes with a group of faculty members from the applicable field. Should the applicant select three supervising professors from three different fields, the applicant will have to take three different interviews.

6. Note

Applicants should carefully read the Entrance Examination Notice – Master's & Doctoral Program, Graduate School of Engineering, the University of Tokyo.

Entering the examination room 30 minutes after the beginning of the examination is prohibited under any circumstances.

1. Examination Dates

Examinations will be held over five days, from August 28 (Monday) through September 1 (Friday), 2017.

(For details on times and location of the examination subjects, refer to "Guide to Entrance Examination" of the department you are applying to.)

2. Examination Location

Refer to the "Campus Map for the Examination" [see the attached paper].

(1) The actual place of the examination subjects for applicants will be posted on the bulletin board for School of Engineering and each department at 10:00 a.m. on August 25 (Friday), 2017.

<u>Confirm the specified place for the examination subjects beforehand.</u> In addition, confirm the bulletin board for the department you are applying to.

Applicants registered for the examination of TOEFL ITP must refer to the "Guide for Applicants Taking the Examination of TOEFL ITP" [see the attached paper]. Note that the examination room of TOEFL ITP, Regular education subjects(一般教育科目(一般学術)), and specialized subjects(專門科目(專門学術)) may differ.

(2) Applicants should arrive at the specified place for the examination subjects 15 minutes prior to the scheduled examination time.

For the examination of specialized subjects(専門科目(専門学術)), also refer to notice by the department you are applying to.

3. Items to Bring

- (1) Examination admission card
- (2) Black pencils (or black mechanical pencils), an eraser, a pencil sharpener (a desktop type is not allowed) and a watch (only with a time measurement function is allowed).
- (3) <u>Use of electronic devices such as cell phones is strictly prohibited throughout the examination, even if you only use it as a watch. Make sure to completely deactivate the alarm setting, turn off the phone power, and put it in your bag before you enter the examination room. Do not take it out in the examination room.</u>
- (4) For the item to bring for the examination of specialized subjects(専門科目(専門学術)), refer to notice by the department you are applying to.

4. Notice during Examination of Regular Education Subjects (一般教育科目 (一般学術))

- (1) Applicants can not leave the examination room after the start of the examination.
- (2) The Examination admission card must be kept on your desk at all times during the examination.
- (3) For the examination of regular education subjects(一般教育科目(一般学術)), applicants must write his/her examinee number on each answer sheet, not his/her name. Applicants must use one answer sheet for each problem. Applicants can use the reverse side if necessary. At the end of the examination, follow your proctor's instructions and carefully tear off the designated places.
- (4) Applicants can not take away the answer sheets and the problem booklets after the examination.

5. The Secondary Examination for Applicants to the Doctoral Program

The secondary examination will be held between late January and mid-February, 2018. Applicants will be advised of Examination dates and location regarding secondary examinations for the department you are applying to later.

6. Miscellaneous

(1) The Examinee Numbers of successful applicants will be posted on the School of Engineering bulletin board at 4:00 p.m. on September 7 (Thursday), 2017.

The Examinee Numbers of successful applicants will be posted on the web site of the School of Engineering by September 8 (Friday), 2017, as well. It will be next from the post time to the bulletin board mentioned above. (The page will be linked from http://www.t.u-tokyo.ac.jp/soe/index.html).

- (2) Successful applicants will be notified of authorization for admission by mail from the day following the announcement of successful applicants. The School will not accept telephone calls, fax, e-mail, and other inquiries regarding the results of the examinations.
