Write your prospective research plan you would like to pursue at the Department of Architecture, the Graduate School of Engineering, the University of Tokyo. Please follow the instructions below to complete your prospective research plan.

(Page 1)

Page 1 must include the following information.

Prospective academic supervisor's name

Proposed research title

Summary of research plan (no more than 300 words)

(Pages 2 to 5)

Your detailed research plan must include the following details.

1. Background of your prospective research plan

Describe your previous research thesis, design thesis, or other academic activities in connection with your prospective research plan, including your motivations for pursuing your proposed research.

2. Research objective

State the objective, ambition and significance of your proposed research.

3. Previous studies and research

Describe precedents and references to substantiate the originality and significance of your proposed research. Appropriate citations must be included.

4. Research method

Explain with a detailed description of the method and processes of conducting the proposed research.

5. Expected results

Describe your vision of the research results, potential applications and societal impacts.

Please note that the following points must be considered in making the research plan throughout all pages from page 1 to page 5.

- Maximum of five pages of A4 paper are allowed. The first page must contain only the research summary, and the rest of pages should include details of research plan.
- Font sizes must be 10 to 11 points with 20 mm margin on all four sides with the line spacing to be determined for optimal readability. The page number should be placed at the bottom center within

the margin.

- You may include figures and tables as needed. You must use an appropriate figure legend.
- Use appropriate citations for all references included in the text.
- Do not include names, photographs, and/or any information which may reveal the identity of the applicant. Your application may be disqualified if any of the above information were included in the research plan.
